

Privacy policy for our profiles on social networks

are jointly responsible with the operator of the social network for the data processing that is triggered when you visit our profile. You can assert your rights as a data subject both against the operator of the social network and against us.

As a data subject, you have the following rights:

- The right for access to information according to Art. 15 GDPR
- The right for rectification of inaccurate data according to Art. 16 GDPR
- The right for erasure of your personal data according to Art. 17 GDPR
- The right for restriction of processing according to Art. 18 GDPR
- The right for withdraw given consent according to Art. 7 (3) GDPR
- The right for data portability according to Art. 20 GDPR
- The right for object to processing according to Art. 21 GDPR
- The right for lodging a complaint to the competent supervisory authority according to Art. 77 GDPR

Data collection and legal basis

The processing of your data when you visit our profile is based on Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR. Our legitimate interest is to ensure the broadest possible presence on the internet through our presence on social networks.

The processing of your data by LinkedIn may be based on different legal grounds, including your consent according to Art. 6 (1) lit. a GDPR. Please refer to the data protection guidelines of LinkedIn for the legal bases on which the operator of the social network bases the processing of your data.

Your data is also processed when you contact us via contact form or messenger. We use the data you enter in the respective contact form to answer your enquiry and for the associated technical administration. The legal basis for the processing of the data is our legitimate interest to respond to your request in accordance with Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR. If your contact aims at the conclusion of a contract, the additional legal basis for the processing is Art. 6 (1) lit. b GDPR.

Note on data transfer to the USA

If the provider of a social network is based in the US, your personal data may be transferred to the US servers of the respective company and processed there.

We point out that the USA is assessed by the European Court of Justice as a country with an insufficient level of data protection according to EU standards.

We have concluded a contract with the providers of these services that includes the so-called EU standard contractual clauses. Taking into account the need for protection of the data, we consider the level of protection in reference to the EU standard contractual clauses to be adequate.
